RE: Brevard Old Red Eye Rugby Football Club – CIPP Registration Violations

---

It has come to the attention of the Florida Rugby Union (“FRU”) Disciplinary Chair that the Brevard Old Red Eye Rugby Football Club (“Brevard”) failed to ensure that all of its players during its March 14, 2009, scheduled match against Krewe RFC (the “Match”) were CIPP-registered with USA Rugby. Brevard player, Bart Longchamp (the “Offender”) was red-carded during such match and was not a CIPP-registered player (see attached USA Rugby CIPP report for Brevard). This is in direct violation of USA Rugby, USA Rugby South, and FRU regulations. As a reminder, it is every club’s responsibility to ensure its players are CIPP-registered with such club.

On November 8, 2005, the FRU Disciplinary Chair published the attached CIPP Registration Advisory (the “Advisory”) reminding all FRU member clubs that “all match participants must be CIPP-registered in order to participate in matches within the Florida Rugby Union and abroad.” The Advisory further stated that any failure of a club to register all match participants participating in any match shall result in serious sanctions, including, but not limited to, probation, forfeiting matches, club suspensions, etc. Again, following additional FRU member clubs failing to ensure their players are CIPP-registered, the FRU published the attached CIPP Registration “Zero Tolerance” Policy on February 8, 2008. To be clear, the FRU will not tolerate clubs failing to ensure all match participants are CIPP-registered.

**Sanction:** As Brevard played an illegal player during the Match, the Match is ruled a forfeit by Brevard, and each other match played by the Offender shall also be forfeited. Brevard is also hereby placed on one (1) year probation for their failure to ensure all match participants are CIPP-registered. Any further violation will automatically result in losing points, forfeiting matches, club suspension, or other sanctions imposed by the FRU. **This sanction will be reported to USA Rugby South and USA Rugby South may impose additional sanctions it deems fit.**

This includes Florida Cup matches during the fall. Any failure of a club to ensure that all match participants participating in any match are CIPP-registered shall result in serious sanctions being levied against such club, including, but not limited to, probation, forfeiting matches, club suspensions, etc. The Florida Rugby Union will not tolerate clubs failing to ensure all match participants are CIPP-registered.

RE: **NEW CIPP REGISTRATION “ZERO TOLERANCE” POLICY**

**ATTENTION:**

The Florida Rugby Union has once again discovered that certain member clubs have been playing matches with match participants that are not CIPP-registered. **Be advised that all match participants must be CIPP-registered in order to participate in matches within the Florida Rugby Union and abroad.** This applies to all matches including B-side and friendlies. Any failure of a club to ensure that all match participants participating in any match are CIPP-registered shall result in an automatic forfeit for any such match played with players that are not CIPP-registered with such club. In addition to the automatic forfeit, the Florida Rugby Union may also levy fines, put such club on probation or suspension, etc. The Florida Rugby Union will not tolerate clubs failing to ensure all match participants are CIPP-registered.
